



Ghebeary Family 1694 : 2020

At the beginning of year 2004 I have got a copy of our Family Tree drawing from Dr. Saaeed Bahgat Hannaala. First of all I would like to introduce Dr. Refky Fares Hannaala. He was the main reason for preserving and completing the information of our family. And this is his comment which was written on the drawing which I received .

On noticing that elderly members and friends of our family pass away, one after the other, with information that totally disappears with their departure, my father, the late Mr. Fares Hennalla Eskarous, compiled and recorded data on the Ghebeary family around the year 1935. He continued to collect data until the early forties when he actually designed a family tree to cover all family members at time, i.e. some fifty years ago. He assigned to an artist the task of drawing a family tree diagram and the outcome was an admirable masterpiece. Mr. Eskarous also wrote a book, which included a history note on each member of the family with relevant anecdotes and something about the domestic political conditions that prevailed from the rule of Mamelukes to date. This book written half a century ago is an honorable record indeed. As much as he yearned for a quality publication of the book, circumstances, during World war2 were far from conducive to the realization of this dream. Some young members of the family who saw the family tree and read the book felt an urge to continue the task. They have made a serious effort to collect supplementary data. The diagram shows the data collected, but these are by no means exhaustive since quite a few members of the family are scattered all over the world particularly in north America and Britain. We hope to complete the data as soon as we receive a brief historical note on each family member and his or her address. Once we have access to all the required information we will issue supplement to the family biography preliminary to its publication and distribution to members by way of cementing family bonds.
